General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will come into force on the 25th May 2018. GDPR is about legal compliance and applies to all organisations that process personal data. It covers the lifecycle of personal data from legal collection, use, sharing, storage & transfer of data. GDPR brings significant legal and operational changes and will transform how businesses handle data.

Organisations will be potentially subject to fines of up to: €10 million or 2% of total annual turnover for breaches.

Kate Ashmore of **Frontier Privacy** will take you through the requirements and pitfalls of the new rules for your business.

PAYE MODERNISATION will introduce fundamental changes to the way employers operate payroll taxes from 1 January 2019.

As employers are you aware that you will be required to advise Revenue of each payment you make to an employee? Fines for non-compliance on the operation of payroll may leave your business exposed financially.

There will be *no* requirement to file P35s or P30s or to issue P60s or P45s for 2019 or subsequent years.
